#### **Help Wanted**

Preschool Instructional Assistant: Part -time (22.5 hours/week).

- IA assists teachers in coordinating a classroom of active children.
- Performs a variety of activities that ensures the health and safety of the group.
- Reports to the teacher and the director.
- Assist the classroom teacher in performance of duties, including (but not limited to)
  attendance, collecting permission slips, executing daily activities with children,
  implementing lesson plans, bathroom brakes, transitioning the class to the playground,
  cleaning the classroom, disinfecting toys and materials, supervision of students, and
  individual, small and large group instruction.
- Provide direct support to children who need additional help.
- Assists in toilet training and diapering, as needed.
- Cleans and organizes the classroom every day.

#### Requirements

- 90 Hour MSDE Preschool Certified or AA degree in ECED
- Knowledge of growth process of children, activities that stimulate children and safety issues
- Skills in patience, positive reinforcement, communication and time management
- Ability to prioritize work, organize environment, react quickly and appropriately
- Must be supportive of Catholic education and Our Lady of Grace pre-school.

We currently have 2 Long-Term Substitutes filling in until the positions are filled. Ms. Marianne is helping in PreK2 and Ms. Debbie is helping in PreK3.
